Rice: About 68.08 lakh ha area coverage under rice has been reported compared to last year (49.23 lakh ha). Thus 18.85 lakh ha more area has been covered compared to last year. Higher area is reported from the States of Chhattisgarh (9.02 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (4.44 lakh ha), Bihar (3.94 lakh ha), Madhya Pradesh (3.80 lakh ha), Haryana (2.91 lakh ha), Telangana (1.36 lakh ha), Maharashtra (1.22 lakh ha), Arunachal Pradesh (1.17 lakh ha), Jharkhand (0.58 lakh ha), Karnataka (0.58 lakh ha), Odisha (0.50 lakh ha), Gujarat (0.45 lakh ha), Mizoram (0.35 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.33 lakh ha), Rajasthan (0.14 lakh ha), Uttarakhand (0.11 lakh ha), Manipur (0.07 lakh ha) and Sikkim (0.01 lakh ha). Less area is reported from the States of Punjab (5.67 lakh ha), Assam (0.37 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.34 lakh ha), J&K (0.16 lakh ha), Kerala (0.10 lakh ha), West Bengal (0.09 lakh ha), Tripura (0.08 lakh ha) and Nagaland (0.07 lakh ha).

Pulses: About 36.82 lakh ha area coverage under pulses has been reported compared to last year (9.46 lakh ha). Thus 27.36 lakh ha more area has been covered compared to last year. Higher area is reported from the States of Maharashtra (11.94 lakh ha), Madhya Pradesh (6.55 lakh ha), Telangana (2.16 lakh ha), Rajasthan (1.97 lakh ha), Karnataka (1.89 lakh ha), Jharkhand (0.89 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (0.68 lakh ha), Gujarat (0.53 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.27 lakh ha), Chhattisgarh (0.21 lakh ha), Bihar (0.19 lakh ha), Haryana (0.12 lakh ha), Uttarakhand (0.10 lakh ha) and J&K (0.03 lakh ha). Less area is reported from the States of Nagaland (0.07 lakh ha), Odisha (0.04 lakh ha), Assam (0.03 lakh ha), Punjab (0.01 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.01 lakh ha) and Tripura (0.01 lakh ha).

Coarse cereals: About 70.69 lakh ha area coverage under coarse cereals has been reported compared to last year (35.20 lakh ha). Thus 35.49 lakh ha more area has been covered compared to last year. Higher area is reported from the States of Maharashtra (11.45 lakh ha), Madhya Pradesh (10.45 lakh ha), Rajasthan (5.16 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (2.48 lakh ha), Bihar (1.31 lakh ha), Gujarat (1.23 lakh ha), Jharkhand (1.20 lakh ha), Haryana (0.78 lakh ha), Punjab (0.72 lakh ha), Karnataka (0.49 lakh ha), Chhattisgarh (0.35 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.28 lakh ha) and J&K (0.19 lakh ha). Less area is reported from the States of Telangana (0.24 lakh ha), Odisha (0.09 lakh ha), Assam (0.05 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.03 lakh ha), Uttarakhand (0.01 lakh ha) and West Bengal (0.01 lakh ha).

Oilseeds: About 109.20 lakh ha area coverage under oilseeds has been reported compared to last year (33.63 lakh ha). Thus 75.57 lakh ha more area has been covered last year. Higher area is reported from the States of Madhya Pradesh (34.79 lakh ha), Maharashtra (29.39 lakh ha), Gujarat (7.27 lakh ha), Karnataka (2.42 lakh ha), Telangana (1.01 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.83 lakh ha), Chhattisgarah (0.62 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (0.16 lakh ha), Bihar (0.15 lakh ha), Jharkhand (0.11 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.07 lakh ha), Arunachal Pradesh (0.07 lakh ha), Haryana (0.02 lakh ha) and Uttarakhand (0.01 lakh ha). **Sugarcane:** About **50.62 lakh ha** area coverage under sugarcane has been reported compared to last year (**49.86 lakh ha**). Thus **0.76 lakh ha more area** has been covered compared to last year. **Higher area** is reported from the States of Maharashtra (1.10 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (0.63 lakh ha), Chhattisgarh (0.01 lakh ha) and Punjab (0.01 lakh ha). **Less area** is reported from the States of Bihar (0.34 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.16 lakh ha), Karnataka (0.14 lakh ha), Gujarat (0.10 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.06 lakh ha), Madhya Pradesh (0.06 lakh ha), Haryana (0.04 lakh ha), Odisha (0.04 lakh ha), Telangana (0.03 lakh ha), West Bengal (0.02 lakh ha) and Uttarakhand (0.02 lakh ha).

**Jute & Mesta:** About **5.89 lakh ha** area coverage under Jute & Mesta has been reported compared to last year **(6.80 lakh ha)**. Thus **0.91 lakh ha less area** has been covered compared to last year. **Higher area** is reported from the States of Meghalaya (0.02 lakh ha). **Less area** is reported from the States of West Bengal (0.82 lakh ha), Bihar (0.04 lakh ha), Assam (0.03 lakh ha), Odisha (0.02 lakh ha) and Andhra Pradesh (0.01 lakh ha).

Cotton: About 91.67 lakh ha area coverage under cotton has been reported compared to last year (45.85 lakh ha). Thus 45.82 lakh ha more area has been covered compared to last year. Higher area is reported from the States of Maharashtra (28.51 lakh ha), Telangana (7.50 lakh ha), Rajasthan (2.83 lakh ha), Madhya Pradesh (2.39 lakh ha), Karnataka (1.38 lakh ha), Gujarat (1.37 lakh ha), Punjab (0.99 lakh ha), Haryana (0.61 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.47 lakh ha), Odisha (0.03 lakh ha) and Tamil Nadu (0.02 lakh ha).
